Directions to Bellport Country Club

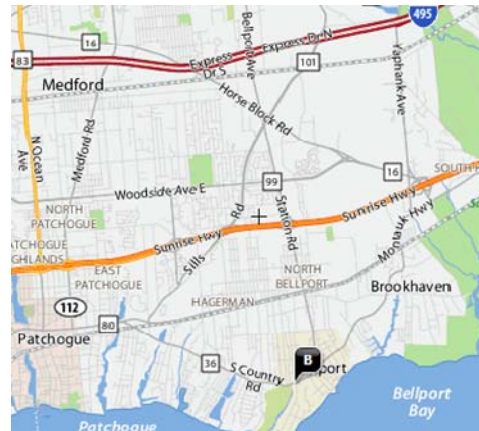
40 South Country Road

Humayun Chaudhry, DO, MS

As Commissioner of Health Services for Suffolk County, New York, Dr. Humayun "Hank" Chaudhry oversees a department with nine divisions, 1,500 employees, and a budget of nearly \$400 million. Board-certified in Internal Medicine, Dr. Chaudhry's professional interests include undergraduate and graduate medical education, preventive medicine and health policy.

Dr. Regensburg is Program Manager of Sudden Infant Death Risk Reduction and Counseling, a program of Public Health Solutions and the NYC Satellite Office of the NYS Center for SID. Dr. Regensburg has worked as an addictions professional for over twenty years, including seven years on a detoxification unit and ten years in private practice. Dr. Regensburg is on faculty at St. Joseph's College, Patchogue, conducting courses on research, community and human services, health administration, and chemical dependency.
